The recipe had a little miscalculation since the prez used DME instead of LME for calculating the og. In the end it turned out just fine with an og of 1.077! The recipe is below-

Steeped Grains:

5 lbs Caramel Wheat Malt (Crushed & Steeped)
10 lbs Light Crystal (Crushed & Steeped)

Malt Extract:

99lbs Light LME (not DME Adam)
16 lbs wheat LME

Hops:

22 oz Northern Brewer for 60 min boil

Finishings:

Whirlfloc Tablets

Yeast:

Brewers choice on yeast either S04 (Blue) or S54 (Red)

Specs:

Diluted to 55g total
1.077 og
64 IBU
